ORDER

In accordance with the law and the verified pleadings in this matter, the undersigned issues a temporary restraining order ordering the defendants to: keep all the polling places in Orleans Parish open until 10:00 p.m. this evening; allow all potential voters standing in line at 10:00 p.m. the opportunity to vote; allow all first-time voters who were wrongfully only allowed to vote provisionally to go back and vote the full ballot on the voting machines; allow all registered voters who have legal identification to fully vote on the voting machine; allow all registered voters who do not have legal identification to vote in accordance with law by executing an affidavit; allow all other people who seek to vote to vote by provisional ballot in accordance with the law.
