Dear Judge Hunt:

Amici Public Citizen, American Civil Liberties Union, the ACLU of Georgia and Electronic Frontier Foundation write in further support of Does 106 and 207's motions to quash, and echo Cox Communication's suggestion that the considerations in those motions be applied to all 252 Doe Defendants named in this Complaint. As amici described in our brief filed February 24, 2004, we believe there are serious constitutional, jurisdiction, and joinder problems with the Plaintiffs' discovery request. Developments since that filing have made those problems even more evident, including Cox's observation that none of the subscribers identified is shown in Cox records as residing in the Northern District of Georgia. In addition, amicus EFF has been contacted by at least three Does in this case who were seeking counsel but were unable to find local counsel to file their own motions to quash.


