**AND NOW**, this 11th day of May, 2004, upon consideration of Plaintiffs' Motion for Leave to Take Immediate Discovery (Doc. 3) and the Amicus Brief of Public Citizen, Electronic Frontier Foundation, American Civil Liberties Union, and ACLU of Pennsylvania Regarding Plaintiffs' Request for Expedited Discovery (Doc. 4), **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECREED** that Plaintiffs' Motion is **GRANTED IN PART**.

1. Plaintiffs may serve immediate discovery on Villanova University to obtain the identity of each Doe Defendant by serving a Rule 45 subpoena that seeks only the name and address of each Defendant.
2. Plaintiffs may only use the information obtained pursuant to this Order to name Defendants in this case, send a letter to Defendants offering settlement of this matter, serve named Defendants with the Complaint filed in this action or dismiss Does not within the jurisdiction of this Court.
