Dear Cox High Speed Internet Customer:

On August 25, members of the Recording Industry Association of America (RIAA) filed two lawsuits against 102 customers of Cox Communications. The lawsuits were filed in the Northern District of Georgia and allege that the 102 unnamed "Doe" defendants have each infringed music copyrights owned by RIAA members through use of peer-to-peer internet services.

The lawsuits list an Internet Protocol (IP) address for each of the defendants. Our records indicate that one of the IP addresses listed was assigned to your Cox High Speed Internet account on the date and time described in the lawsuit.

In order to identify the defendants, RIAA has asked the court to order Cox to provide your name, address, telephone number and email address from our records. If required by the court, the information that we would be required to provide is listed for you on the page enclosed. We will not turn over this information to RIAA until a subpoena is issued and the court rules on any objections that may be filed.

The purpose of this notice is to inform you of the lawsuits so that you have the opportunity to file objections and to raise any legal defenses you may have. We do not yet know when we may be required to answer the subpoena, but will post updated information for you on our website, as explained below.

We regret being placed in the position of sending this letter, but want you to have every opportunity to protect your interests. We are not permitted to give you legal advice and urge you to consult an attorney familiar with copyright law immediately.

Because this matter involves litigation, our Customer Care staff will not be able to assist you with questions you may have. To provide you with as much factual information as possible, we have set up a page on our Internet website accessible at <http://www.cox.net/filessharing>. This page provides information on the RIAA filings, answers to some practical questions you may have and links to other websites that may be of help to you.
