DCP asserts that HDCP does > include such controls, and as indicated by a prior message from DTLA, is > so expressly named under the DTCP license. > DCP requests that the Final Report of the BPDG should list on Table A the > HDCP technology in addition to any other technologies that satisfy the > proposed criteria.
